The Client is the Gujarat State Forest Development Corporation Limited (GSFDC) and is affiliated with the National Agriculture Commission (NAC). The Client organization was founded in 1976 to accelerate progress and development of the forestry sector. One of its main objectives is to eliminate the private trade used by forest dwellers to derive profit from the collection of Minor Forest Produce and to protect the economic interest of tribal cultures and other constituents. One of its major objectives is to protect and support the interests of the tribal and indigenous communities by providing local employment and protecting natural resources.

The Objective

The Client wished to automate the complete process of procurement, manufacturing, selling, inventory management and distribution of goods within different units of the corporation. Corporate units include: Charcoal Trading, Plantation Project, Dhanvantari Unit, Minor Forest Produce (MFP) and Vanil Udhyog. The Client also needed a process by which it could generate and track bills, receipts and invoices automatically through a system, and the ability to easily report on the information in the system, thereby improving data literacy and empowering the organization with accurate, timely information.

Minor Forest Produce (MFP) Background and Highlights

The core activities of this organization are to collect, process and market certain forest products, e.g., Timru leaves, Mahuda flowers and Mahuda seeds (Doli). The core objectives include protecting the economic interests of the Scheduled Tribes, the Scheduled Castes and other sectors of society who, through engagement in MFP collection activity and employment within their community to help sustain and improve lifestyle and financial security.

Core functions of MFP activities are:

- Collection of Minor Forest Produce at remunerative prices ensuring economic improvement for MFP collecting communities
- Processing and marketing of MFP to make available genuine forest products for industries and consumers
- Imparting training to primary collectors of MFP to improve qualitative and quantitative yield of MFP, thereby supporting tribal interests
- Preventing exploitation of tribal interests by eliminating intermediaries and payment of better wages
- Holding seminars, organizing exhibitions and undertaking research and development programs to create awareness about MFP among primary collectors, traders, consumers, industries and the public at large

Dhanvantari Background and Highlights

Minor Forest Produce collected by GSFDC include Amla, Baheda, Harda, Brahmi etc. which form the basic raw material for manufacture of herbal medicines. In 1991, GSFDC established a plant (Dhavantari) to process herbal medicines.

The core functions of Dhavantari unit include:

- Manufacture of Ayurvedic medicines in different forms
- Processing, filtration and bottling of wild honey
- Distribution of pure ayurvedic medicines and honey through retail sale counters to consumers
- Holding seminars and organizing exhibitions to create public awareness
- Organizing health check-ups and medical camps under supervision of qualified medical practitioners in semi-urban and rural areas

Vanil Udyog Background and Highlights

The original GSFDC core activities involved collection, processing and marketing of MFP. This activity was largely for trade and dependent upon the vagaries of nature. Vanil Udyog was established in 1982, to support tribal business initiatives during MFP lean years.

The core functions of Vanil Udyog are:

- Procurement of round timber, sawn sizes and consumable stores items.
- Manufacture of door-window frames and shutters and furniture items
- Sale of wooden items and genuine high-quality products and services.
- Service to society by providing employment to tribal communities and ensuring environmental protection and safety
- Manufacture and supply of school benches to primary schools using steel and wood
- Execution of renovation and furnishing projects for Government offices, Education institutes, Courts etc.
